BIG TRANSITION MADE EASY

TO STAY ON TRACK FOR DIRECTCONNECT TO UCF, YOU SHOULD:

- ❑ Be an A.A. or articulated A.S. degree-seeking state college student at one of the DirectConnect to UCF partner institutions
- ❑ Sign up for DirectConnect to UCF as soon as you start at one of our state college partners or before you earn 15 college credits. Visit directconnect.ucf.edu.
- ❑ Complete ENC 1101, ENC 1102 and two college-level math courses (College Algebra or higher) before completing 45 college credit hours (for A.A. students)

UNDER 15 to 30 CREDIT HOURS:

- ❑ Attend an information session for your selected UCF major
- ❑ Visit “UCF Success Pathways” to view information and pre-requisites for UCF majors
- ❑ Schedule an appointment with a UCF Success Coach to discuss major requirements

AT 45 CREDIT HOURS EARNED:

- ❑ Meet with a UCF Success Coach at your UCF Connect Center, by phone, or virtually
- ❑ Apply for admission to UCF at admissions.ucf.edu and pay the application fee
- ❑ Submit official high school and college transcripts (from all schools attended) and any CLEP, AP and IB scores to UCF

GRADUATING SEMESTER:

- ❑ Apply for graduation by your state college deadline
- ❑ Complete the FAFSA at fafsa.gov. Use the UCF Title IV code: 003954
- ❑ Send final state college transcripts to UCF (select the “Hold for Degree Statement” option if available and the degree has not been awarded)

FINAL STEPS:

- ❑ Check your UCF admission status in your Future Knight Portal
- ❑ Once admitted, complete the immunization requirements
- ❑ Once admitted, attend a mandatory UCF Transfer Student Orientation
