



## INTERNATIONAL STUDENT **Transfer Process**

### STEP 5: : REQUEST A FORM I-20 FROM UCF GLOBAL (deadlines listed on page

1) To request a Form I-20, please visit [myINTL](#).

The following documents are required to request a Form I-20:

- Copy of Passport
- Financial Support Documents
- Copy of F-1 Visa or USCIS Notice of Action
- [Transfer Clearance Form](#)
- Most recent [Form I-94](#)
- Most recent Form I-20

To access [myINTL](#), you will need your Network ID (NID) and password. If you do not know your NID or password, please visit [myUCF](#) and select “What is my NID?”

**STEP 6: COMPLETE THE “UCF GLOBAL REQUIRED ONLINE INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ORIENTATION” AND ATTEND YOUR IMMIGRATION CHECK-IN SESSION** After you are admitted to UCF, you will be enrolled in the Online International Student Orientation in WebCourses. Log into [webcourses.UCF.edu](#) using your NID and password to complete the orientation. In the WebCourse, you will receive a link to register for an immigration Check in Session. **STEP 7: SUBMIT YOUR IMMUNIZATION FORM AND PROOF OF HEALTH INSURANCE TO UCF STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES** All UCF students must complete an Immunization Form (at [studenthealth.ucf.edu/immunizations](#) > UCF Mandatory Immunizations) and submit it online to UCF Student Health Services before registering for classes/ International students (F-1 and J-1) must also submit proof of health insurance meeting the Florida Board of Governors requirements. **STEP 8: REGISTER FOR AND ATTEND TRANSFER STUDENT ORIENTATION** All transfer students are required to attend Transfer Orientation. To find out the dates for orientation, and to register, visit the UCF Orientation website at: [orientation.ucf.edu](#).

### FINANCIAL AID—INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS
